ORDER

At the very out-set, the learned counsel for the petitioner has stated at bar that the petitioner has retired from service after attaining the age of superannuation but his retirement order has not been issued by the respondents and the respondents may kindly be directed to issue the same. He has further stated that according to para-3 of affidavit tendered by the respondents management wherein clearly given statement that the respondent authority SRBC has no objection to release the remaining funds/amounts of the petitioner as per details of the funds regarding which requisition has been made to release to the concerned in compliance with the order of the high court, therefore, the instant grievance petition may kindly be disposed of in the above terms. The learned counsel for the respondents has also supported the statement of learned counsel for the petitioner.

2. Keeping in view of above statement of learned counsels for the parties, the instant grievance petition is disposed of accordingly with the direction to the respondents to issue office order regarding retirement of the petitioner. If the remaining dues/amount etc is not paid by the respondents as per para-3 of the affidavit tendered by the respondents which is placed on record, the petitioner would be at liberty to file fresh grievance petition in accordance with law. File be consigned to record after due completion. Announced.
