At the very out-set, the learned counsel for the petitioner has stated at bar that according to para-3 of affidavit tendered by the respondents management wherein clearly given statement that the respondent authority SRBC has no objection to release the remaining funds/amounts of the petitioner as per details of the funds regarding which requisition has been made to relase to the concerned in compliance with the order of the high court, therefore, the instant grievance petition may kindly be disposed of in the above terms.
