This petition has been filed by the complainant with the prayer that the complaint may be accepted and the contempt proceeding may kindly be initiated against the respondents No.1 to 4 they be dealt strictly in accordance with law for not complying with the order dated 19.12.2025 passed by this Hon'ble Court.

2. Today Mr. Muhammad Fahad, Advocate has entered appearance and filed the power of attorney on behalf of the respondents alongwith letter No.PMSL/IRS/2026/0651 dated 06.03.2026 issued by Punjab Modaraba Services Pvt. Limited (A Wholly Owned Subsidiary of the Bank of Punjab) through its head HR Services. According to which, the petitioner has allowed to join his duty at the place from where he was stopped to serve the respondent organization at the same perks & privileges which he was receiving at the time of his stoppage of work.

3. Perusal of the above said letter depicts that the order dated 19.12.2025 has been complied with in toto, but to the extent of the salaries and

other perks & privileges. The learned counsel for the respondents also made a statement at bar that the services of the petitioner will not be terminated/stopped on this score alone, even the grievance petition is dismissed under Order 7 Rule 11 CPC.

4. So, in this assurance given by the learned counsel for the respondents, the instant contempt petition is hereby disposed of. No order as to costs. File be consigned to the record room after its due completion.
